“Oh the places you will go: Research Adventures beyond academia”

This talk will explore post-doctoral research funded by the National Academy of Science and performed at the Naval Air Weapons Station: China Lake, as well the professional work currently being performed at SAIC. The work performed at China Lake involved investigating synthetic strategies for the formation of low-valent aluminum clusters and well as the 2+2 cycloaddition of alkenes and dienes as a path toward renewable fuels and lubricants.

The projects at SAIC are highly varied and range from counterfeit electronics detection, from IC's to PrCB's, and the additive manufacturing of electronics (batteries, sensors, interconnects) and energetics.
